EEFI CONDEMNS NEXUS OF THE GOVERNMENT AND ITS CRONIES

EEFI notes with grave concern the news item published in lead national newspapers today relating arrest warrant issued by a Gujarat Court against senior journalist Paranjoy Guha Thakurta. EEFI Condemns the Government machinery of Gujarat as well Union, who shamelessly backed Mundra. EEFI also noted that Editors Guild of India has also condemned this move against a reputed introspective journalist. Electricity Employees Federation of India appreciates relentless effort of Shri Guha Thakurta to unveil the energy sector scams to grab profit by Adani and Ambani with unlawful support by the Government.

Mundra Court accepted the defamation case lodged by Adani Power against Paranjoy Guha Thakurta for his article published in esteemed journal Economic and Political Weekly in June, 2017.
